#### A. General Points:

- 1. An orientation session regarding the course outline, assessments, ungraded activities etc. to be done by the respective PRA on **launch** day of the course.

- 3. Office hours Wednesday 4-5 pm every week. Same day and timings to be adhered to for all courses.
- 4. If the live session is taking place on the same day, then no office hours will be conducted on that day.
- 5. If the PRA is unable to hold office hours on a particular day, the buddy PRA will be present for it.

#### B. Assessment and Grading Related:

#### 1. Grading policy/weightage

- 2. PRAs will keep 2 sets of assessments for mid and end course assessments. All questions will be substantiated with explanations for incorrect options / explaining rationale behind the correct option.
- 3. The minimum percentage for passing the course is 50% individually in mid and end course assessments.
- 4. 90% marks will be calculated based on the graded assessments.
- 5. The rest of the 10% will be awarded as follows for attendance and participation:





- 5 marks will be allocated to those who attend at least 2 out of the 3 live zoom sessions during the course.
- 5 marks will be allocated to those who participate in the zoom session.
   This could either be by
  - Contributing questions on the google form circulated before the session.
  - Questions during the session questions relevant to topic / discussion during the session
  - If the learner's video is switched-on and learner is present during the live session.
  - Answering polls (if any) during the session

#### 6. At the end of the cool off week of each course:

- Grades will be announced individually to all the learners.
- Appreciation announcements of those who have logged in to all the 3 live sessions and participated actively.
- The top 3 performers of each course will be announced and books regarding the course will be sent to them. (This will be based on all criteria participation, assessment performance and timely submission)

#### 7. For learners who are not adhering to schedule:

- Nudge mails sent to those who do not view videos/attempt assessments (with a gap of at least 2 days between mails)
- After 3 nudge mails, learner to be called over phone and spoken to. This will be followed up with a mail mentioning the call.

#### 8. For learners who have been unsuccessful in the assessment

- At the end of week 4, we will check for learners who may have failed one or both assessments in that course.
- Retest with new set of questions to be given to the learners during the buffer week. Email notifications will be sent to learners.
- The questions in this attempt will be slightly more complex and higher in difficulty as compared to the original attempt.
- This attempt will be kept open only for 2 days.





## • Failure / Non completion of assessments will lead to un-enrolment from the program.

#### 9. Policy on extensions of assessment dates in exceptional circumstances:

- The learner needs to inform us through mail requesting for an extension along with the reason for the same before the end of buffer period.
- The learner may be awarded an extension of 2-3 days for assessments after the buffer period (based on the discretion of the professor and IIMBx staff)
- Extensions can be given for a maximum of 3 out of the 10 courses.
- No appreciation / prizes will be given to the learner for that course if extension has been availed of.

#### 10. Group Projects:

- Groups will be created beforehand, and learners will be intimated about it well in advance.
- Groups will be shuffled for every group project.
- The topic/question, template and assessment rubric will be communicated to learners in advance.
- Group project to be conducted during the live zoom session.
- Learners will join breakout rooms according to their group numbers/codes given.
- One member in the group to be the group leader.
- Time will be given during the live session to discuss their project in their BORs.
- Project reports to be submitted by the group leader within the allotted time
- Project reports to contain the contribution by each group member –
  presentation/research/organization of meetings and keeping minutes of
  meeting etc.
- Passive members of the group do not get the same score as active members.
- Learners who are unable to join the live session on that particular day.
  - 1. Need to inform the IIMBx team beforehand.
  - 2. Need to contact other group members and contribute to the project.
